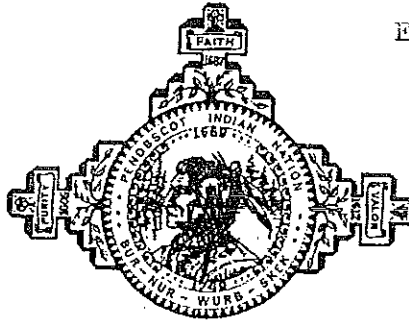

Dear Commissioner Martin:



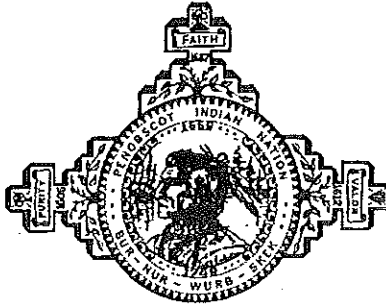


