GOVERNMENT'S PLEA AGREEMENT SUBMISSION  
OF ELEMENTS AND PENALTIES FOR 18 U.S.C. § 1170(a)

Judge Smith

1. ELEMENTS: 18 U.S.C. § 1170(a)  
(Misdemeanor)

First: Defendant knowingly sold, purchased, used for profit, or transported for sale or profit the human remains of a Native American;

Second: Defendant did so without the right of possession to those remains as provided in the Native American Graves Protection and Repatriation Act; and

Third: This activity occurred in the Southern District of Ohio on or about the date alleged in the Bill of Information.

2. PENALTIES

A. Mandatory Minimum: None.

B. Possible Maximum: One year in prison, a fine of \$100,000, a one year term of supervised release, and \$25 special assessment.
