PROPOSEDI ORDER DENYING NOOKSACK POLICE CHIEF'S MOTION TO VACATE ORDER DOMESTICATING FOREIGN JUDGMENT AND QUASH **EXECUTION AND ENFORCEMENT EFFORTS** 

This matter came before the Court on Nooksack Police Chief Rory Gilliland's Motion to Vacate Order Domesticating Foreign Judgment and Quash Execution and Enforcement Efforts pursuant to CR 60(b). Dkt. No. 37. This Court held a hearing regarding the matter on December 9, 2016. Having considered the Motion, the Response in opposition, and the files and records herein, and this Court being fully advised, hereby finds and orders as follows:

## I. **FINDINGS**

- This Court possesses personal jurisdiction over Petitioners and Mr. Gilliland, and 1. subject matter jurisdiction to register a foreign judgment pursuant to the Uniform Enforcement of Foreign Judgments Act, Chapter 6.36 RCW.
- 2. The Court's Order granting Petitioners' unopposed Petition for Entry of Foreign Judgment issued on October 21, 2016, is not void under CR 60(b)(5). Mr. Gilliland, therefore, is entitled to no relief pursuant to CR 60(b)(5).
- This Court accords substantial deference to the October 17, 2016 and November 3. 14, 2016 decisions of Lawrence S. Roberts, Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary of Indian Affairs for the United States Department of the Interior, to not recognize as lawful or carrying

1	this issue that would be recognized as valid by the United States government, that Order is the Order of the Noobsack Court of Appendix at issue herein, any legal effect the actions or decisions of the Nooksack Tribal Council after March 24, 2016,
2	including any action or decision to create the "Nooksack Supreme Court." This Court, therefore,
3	does not recognize any such post-March 24, 2016 actions or decisions of the Nooksack Tribal
4	Council or "Nooksack Supreme Court." Nor does this Court recognize the November 17, 2016
5	Order issued by Nooksack Tribal Court "Judge Pro Tempore" Milton G. Rowland in Nooksack
6	Indian Tribe v. Northwest Intertribal Court System, to which Petitioners are not a party.
7	4. This Court's October 21, 2016 Order and Judgment Awarding Costs is not
8	vacated or reversed per CR 60(b)(6). Mr. Gilliland, therefore, is not entitled to any relief under
9	CR 60(b)(6).
10	II. ORDER
11	Nooksack Police Chief Rory Gilliland's Motion to Vacate Order Domesticating Foreign
12	Judgment and Quash Execution and Enforcement Efforts pursuant to CR 60(b) is hereby
13	<b>DENIED</b> . The Court's Order granting Petitioners' unopposed Petition for Entry of Foreign
14	Judgment issued on October 21, 2016, is hereby <b>AFFIRMED</b> .
