This Court possesses jurisdiction because the subject matter of this suit is real 20 property located in Whatcom County, that acts herein occurred and will occur in Whatcom 21 County, and Defendants are situated in Whatcom County. The Court also possesses jurisdiction 22 pursuant to RCW 37.12.010 and *State v. Cooper*, 130 Wash.2d 770 (1996) (en banc). 23 2. Plaintiff lacks a plain, complete, speedy and adequate remedy at law. 24

- 3. Plaintiff possesses a clear legal or equitable right to her residential property located at 5913 Johnny Drive in Deming, Washington ("property").
- 4. Plaintiff has a well-grounded fear that Defendants will immediately invade her legal or equitable right to her property.
- 5. Plaintiff will likely sustain actual and substantial injuries if the Court does not enjoin Defendants from trespassing and removing Plaintiff from her property.
- 6. Plaintiff is therefore entitled to an order temporarily enjoining Defendants from entering her property.

II. TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

Plaintiff's Motion for Temporary Restraining Order is hereby **GRANTED.** Defendants Rory Gilliland, Michael Ashby and any similarly situated John Doe Defendants are temporarily restrained from entering onto or attempting to remove Plaintiff or her family or belongings from her residential property located at 5913 Johnny Drive in Deming, Washington.

A preliminary injunction hearing is set for Mury 19, 2017. Plaintiff shall immediately attempt to serve process upon Defendants and file proof of service or attempted service with the Court. Plaintiff shall file any additional motion papers nine days before the hearing. Defendants shall file any response papers four days before the hearing. Plaintiff shall file reply papers two days before the hearing.
