DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Assist Legislative Counsel in drafting and revising codes, ordinances, and lawmaking processes and development of resolutions and statutes as enumerated in Article V, Sec. 2 (a-x) and Sec. 3 of the Ho-Chunk Nation Constitution.
- 2. Attend Legislative Committee meetings.
- 3. Provide administrative support to Legislative Counsel.
- 4. Monitor both state and federal Legislative Counsel.
- 5. Must aid and coordinate response to state, federal, and county political activities and legislation.
- 6. Must occasionally serve as Attorney of Record in court proceedings.
- 7. Establish and periodically review protocols and procedures on government relations.
- 8. Is responsible for advising clients, both verbally and in written memorandum on matters raised during Legislative session and Committee meetings.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: (REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE & EXPERIENCE)

- 1. Must be a graduate of a law school accredited by the ABA.
- 2. Must possess a law degree or must be eligible for or admitted to the practice of law in the State of Wisconsin and the Ho-Chunk Bar Association.
- 3. Must be a member in good standing of the Wisconsin State Bar.
- 4. Must also be eligible for admission to practice in the federal courts.
- 5. Possess knowledge of Indian Law.
- 6. Must demonstrate superior written and oral communication skills.
- 7. Must be able to work in a cross-cultural environment.
- 8. This is an entry level position, salary may be negotiated to reflect experience and specialized skills/practices.
