**Duties & Responsibilities:** Support the development and coordination of tribal priorities in the work of Puget Sound recovery. Advance issues important to recovery through issue analysis, communication, coordination and technical assistance. Support policy and technical representatives who engage in the Puget Sound Federal Task Force, the Puget Sound Partnership (PSP), implementation of the Puget Sound Comprehensive Conservation Management Plan (CCMP) and related processes to ensure protection of tribal rights and resources. Work effort is aimed at the identification, understanding and integration of tribal priorities into all recovery processes including implementation of the PSP Action Agenda and Salmon Recovery plans.

**Qualifications:** Master degree in Environmental Science, Public Administration, or related field and six years of pertinent work experience, JD and five years; OR Bachelor degree in Environmental Science, Public Administration or related field and seven years of pertinent work experience. Knowledgeable of the tribes' natural resource management programs and objectives. Must possess excellent communication, analytical, and writing skills. Applicant must demonstrate skills and capacity important to policy and strategy development including inter-governmental communication, meeting facilitation and issue communication / coordination.
