ORDER

The response required in paragraph (2) of the July 22 Order shall not exceed seven (7) pages and the replies required in paragraph (2) of the July 22 Order shall not exceed five (5) pages.


It is further ORDERED that the Statements of Position required by paragraph (3) of the July 22 Order shall state positions in summary form and shall not exceed seven (7) pages in length. The response required in paragraph (4) of the July 22 Order shall not exceed seven (7) pages and the replies required in paragraph (4) of the July 22 Order shall not exceed five (5) pages.

In calling for Statements of Position, the Court only wants to be able to understand the issues left to be decided and, at

this point, is not interested in briefing on the substantive issues.

The Clerk is directed to also file a copy of this ORDER in the following cases: Galloway v. Williams, et al., Misc. No. 3:19mc9; Williams, et al. v. Microbilt Corporation, Misc. No. 3:19mc14; and Weddle v. Williams, et al., Misc. No. 3:19mc15.
