
ORAL ARGUMENT NOT REQUIRED

they should not be held in civil contempt of the Tenth
Circuit Court Appeal in, Ute Indian Tribe v. State of

Utah, (Ute VI), 780 F. 3d 1000 (10th Cir. 2015), the time has come to respect the peace and maintain Uintah Valley Reserve promises. In this event involving the 10th Circuit Court ruling provisions and the Defendants have persisted in failing to respect the ruling of Ute Indian Tribe v. State of Utah, (Ute V), 114 F. 3d 1513 (10th Cir. 1997), that has caused individuals like Plaintiff states costs and fees, they may expect to meet with sanctions in the Federal District Court. 

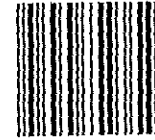
